ORDINANCE NO. 99-<u>2</u> AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 99-3 DATED MAY 22, 1999

Shore for rezoning of the real estate commonly known as 610 North Fifth Street, Rockport, Indiana, from zoning now classified as R-1 (single family residential district) and C-2 (medium commercial district) to C-3 (heavy commercial district) and the council having considered the petition for rezoning of Yvonne L. BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Rockport, Indiana that the following described real estate commonly known as 610 North Fifth Street, Rockport, Indiana be and is hereby rezoned from R-1 (single family residential district) and C-2 (medium commercial district) to C-3 (heavy commercial district):

The north half of Inlot Number Thirty-seven in Wright and Griffith's Donation to the town (now City) of Rockport, Indiana, EXCEPT ten (10) feet of uniform width off the entire south side thereof.

ALSO, Ninety-two and five tenths (92.5) feet of uniform width off of the south side of Inlot Number Thirty Seven (37) in Wright and Griffith's Donation to the town (now City) of Rockport, Spencer County, Indiana,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Rockport that the zoning ordinance and zoning maps adopted on May 22, 1999, Zoning Ordinance No. 99-3 be and are hereby amended in accordance with this ordinance.
