

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1993-4
ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE CREATING TELEVISION FUND

WHEREAS, there is a need for funding for Channel 3 in addition to funding by donations;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Rockport and the general public that the programming for Channel 3 be funded by both government funds and by voluntary contributions from the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKPORT, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:

1. That 50% of all monies received by the City of Rockport for franchise fees from television franchises shall be deposited into the Television Fund for use as provided by Ordinance No. 1993-4. However, monies may be transferred from the Television Fund upon action of the Common Council in accordance with statutory law governing such actions.

2. That all provisions of Ordinance No. 1993-4, except as amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
