

ORDINANCE 2001- 7
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING POLICE RESERVES
AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1992-3

BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1: The Chief of Police of the City of Rockport, Indiana, is hereby authorized, subject to the annual salary ordinance and appropriations restriction, to employ up to 15 police reserves pursuant to I.C. 36-8-3-20.


SECTION 2: Police reserves shall be known as police reserves or patrolman, as designated by the Chief of Police.


SECTION 3: All police reserves shall be subject to the same background check before employment as a regular member of the department. All reserves shall receive training by the office of the Chief in criminal law, traffic law, firearms, patrol procedure and the department's standard operating procedures.


SECTION 4: No reserve officer shall be assigned alone to patrol duty until such officer has spent at least six (6) months in the company of a regular member of the department. The requirement of this section may be waived on a case-by-case basis by the Chief if he does so in writing setting out the need for such waiver.


SECTION 5: Compensation paid to police reserves is deemed compensation as defined by I.C. 36-8-3-20.


