RESOLUTION 2010- 2

The Common Council of the City of Rockport, Indiana met in regular session on the 1st day of February, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall, 426 Main Street, Rockport, Indiana, after due notice thereof as required by law. The Clerk Treasurer informed the Common Council that the City has been paying a mileage reimbursement rate in the amount of \$.44 per mile which is the rate that was paid by the State of Indiana. The present State of Indiana rate for mileage reimbursement is now \$.40 per mile. After discussion of the appropriate rate for mileage reimbursement, upon the motion of Flam Hall seconded by Bab mach, and carried by the undersigned, the Common Council adopted the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Rockport, Indiana that, until such time as this resolution is repealed or rescinded, the City of Rockport shall pay its officers, officials, and employees a mileage reimbursement rate for use of a private motor vehicle driven in behalf of the City of Rockport at the same rate that it is currently paid by the State of Indiana. At the time of this resolution, that rate is \$.40 per mile, and such rate shall be applicable retroactive to January 1, 2010.

All of which is hereby resolved this 1st of February, 2010.
