LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT**

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROCKPORT AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF
THE PFP APPLICATION TO THE INDIANA OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AND RURAL AFFAIRS
AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Rockport City Council recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits: and


WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government for the elimination and prevention of blight; and

WHEREAS, the Rockport City Council has conducted a public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low-and moderate-income residents:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Rockport City Council that:

1. The Rockport Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address the historic preservation of the former auto parts and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
2. The Rockport City Council hereby commit the requisite local funds in the amount of \$53,219 in the form of AEP Capital Funds and \$2,781 in the form of Spencer County Community Foundation funds as the local match for said program, contingent upon receipt of CDBG funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
