**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROCKPORT, INDIANA
AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF A GRANT ADMINISTRATOR
FOR THE
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ("CDBG"),
HOUSING OWNER-OCCUPIED REHABILITATION (OOR) APPLICATION
TO THE
INDIANA HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (IHCA)**

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain affordable housing to benefit its citizens;

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, allows the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority ("IHCA") to award grants to local units of government to meet the affordable housing and community development needs of low and moderate income persons;


WHEREAS, the City is submitting a grant application to the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority for funding to rehabilitate homes of low and moderate income-eligible people;

WHEREAS, the City formally sent out to consulting firms and published in the Spencer County Leader and the Spencer County Journal Democrat a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Grant Administration, Environmental Review and Project Delivery Services; and


