RESOLUTION 2019- 1

TO USE ALTERNATE METHOD TO LEASE PORTION OF CITY PARK

The Common Council of the City of Rockport, Indiana has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City to lease an area of approximately 4,225 square feet in size located in the Rockport City Park near the entrance off 9th Street, pursuant to the alternative method of disposal set forth in Indiana Code 36-1-11-12.

BE IT RESOLVED that The Common Council hereby determines that the procedure for disposing of property by lease set forth in Indiana Code 36-1-11-10 is not feasible for the following reason:

The City would like to consider leasing the area at issue for the purpose of the installation of a communications tower, and the procedure set forth in 36-1-11-10 would not be feasible because it would entail leasing the property for different uses.




