

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-03

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES FOR WATER

USAGE METERED AT ROCKPORT WATER PLANT

WHEREAS, the Common Council City of Rockport deems it to be in the best interest of the City and the citizens of Rockport to have available for the public, including the citizens of Rockport, municipal water which may be purchased in bulk.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKPORT, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I.

METERED WATER

The City of Rockport Indiana, at its discretion, shall maintain a facility at the Rockport Water Plant, 517 Sycamore Street, Rockport, IN. 47635 for purchase of Rockport's municipal water in bulk.

SECTION II.

RATE

Unless amended, supplemented or rescinded, the public may purchase municipal water from Rockport's metered facility at the rate of twenty-five (25) cents for approximately thirty-eight (38) gallons of water. Because of the nature and operations of the metered facility, which measures the quantity of water, the actual amount of gallonage purchased for twenty-five cents may vary between thirty-five (35) and forty (40) gallons.

SECTION III.

DURATION OF SERVICE

The City of Rockport shall provide the metered water service described herein so long as the City of Rockport deems it economically feasible to maintain such metered water facility. The City of Rockport reserves the right to discontinue and rescind this service and the Ordinance governing it.

SECTION IV.

AMENDMENTS

City of Rockport may amend the rates provided for herein from time to time.

SECTION V.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Rockport and the signing by the Mayor.
