ORDINANCE NO. 5

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE OF
DEMOLITION DERBY VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Rockport, Indiana, meeting in regular session on July 24th, 2003, has considered and resolved to regulate the maintenance and storage of demolition derby vehicles.

WHEREAS, the maintenance of vehicles used for demolition derbies and similar recreational events between the hours of 9 p.m. and 9 a.m. is harmful to the public welfare and good order to the citizens of the city.

WHEREAS, the prolonged storage of said vehicles within the city of Rockport without the use of tarpaulins is harmful to the public welfare and good order to the citizens of the city.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKPORT, INDIANA, as follows:

Section 1. No repairing, modifying, or dismantling, unless within fully enclosed buildings and which will not constitute a nuisance to adjoining property owners or occupants, shall be allowed upon any recreational vehicle used for demolition derbies or similar events between the hours of 9 p.m. and 9 a.m .

Section 2. Any vehicles, within the city of Rockport and not located in a fully-enclosed building, used for demolition derbies or similar recreational purposes shall be fully covered by a suitable tarpaulin after three (3) days of their initial presence on any private property within the city of Rockport.

Section 3. Any person, firm, or corporation, whether a principal, agent, employee, or otherwise, who violates any provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of an infraction, and, upon conviction, shall be fined twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for a first offense and fifty dollars (\$50.00) for any subsequent offense, such fine to inure to the City of Rockport. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 4. The remedies provided for herein shall be cumulative and not exclusive and shall be in addition to any other remedies provided by law.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage, approved and due publication according to law.


