ORDINANCE NO. <u>1005-</u> INTRODUCED BY: Rockport City Attorney PETITIONER: Bissey Investments, L.L.C.

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE CERTAIN PLATTED PUBLIC ALLEY WITHIN THE CITY OF ROCKPORT, INDIANA

BE IT ORDERED by the Common Council of the City of Rockport, Indiana, as follows, to-wit:

Section I. That pursuant to MCE Section 9.96.06.70, a sworn petition, was presented to the Common Council of the City of Rockport, requesting that the platted alley described in Section III, below, be vacated by the City of Rockport.

Section II. That after due and proper notice, a timely public hearing was convened by the Common Council, at which time all interested persons were permitted to address the Common Council regarding said vacation.

Section III. That the Common Council of the City of Rockport, after due investigation and consideration, has determined that the nature and extent of the public use and the public interests to be subserved are such as to warrant the vacation of that part of the platted public alley described as follows, and further indicated by the words "To Be Vacated" on the drawing hereto attached, which is made a part of this Ordinance:

Part of Wright and Griffith's Donation to the Town (now City) of Rockport per plat thereof being recorded in Plat Book 1, Page 3 in the office of the Recorder of Spencer County, Indiana, being the same alley being bordered on the north by Lots 36 and 51 and on the south by Lots 37 and 50 of said Wright and Griffith's Donation, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of said Lot 36, said point being on the west right-of-way line of Fifth Street; thence along the west line of Fifth Street South 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East 12.00 feet to the northeast corner of said Lot 37; thence along the north line of said Lots 37 and 50 North 89 degrees 14 minutes 52 seconds West 264.00 feet to the northwest corner of said Lot 50, said point being on the east right-of-way line of Sixth Street; thence along the east line of Sixth Street North 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 12.00 feet to the southwest corner of said Lot 51; thence along the south line of said Lots 51 and 36 South 89 degrees 14 minutes 52 seconds East 264.00 feet to the point of beginning containing 3168 square feet (0.0727 acre).



Therefore, the Common Council of the City of Rockport, Indiana, does hereby find the above-described platted public alley is no longer required for public use, and the public interest will be served by such vacation, and the Common Council of the City of Rockport does hereby vacate that portion of the platted public alley described in Section III, above, subject to the terms and conditions as stated in this Ordinance.
