

RESOLUTION 2009-6


The Common Council of the City of Rockport, Indiana met in regular session on November 2, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall, Rockport, Indiana, after due notice thereof as required by law. It was brought to the attention of the Council that FEMA has reimbursed the City in the sum of Twenty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-One Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$26,391.20) for expenditures arising out of wind damage from Hurricane Ike and the ice storm and that the cost of recovery for local roads and streets and for the park had been borrowed from MVH. In view of such reimbursement, MVH should be replenished to the extent of such expenditures in the amount of Twenty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-One Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$26,391.20), one half being from LRS and one half from Park. Upon the motion of Ferman, seconded by JACK, and unanimously carried by the undersigned, the Common Council passed the following resolution:


BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of City of Rockport, Indiana that Thirteen Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$13,195.60) from the LRS Fund (Acct. 202) and Thirteen Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$13,195.60) from the Park Fund (Acct. 204) shall be transferred to MVH Fund (Acct. 201).


All of which is hereby resolved this 2nd day of November, 2009.
