

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RATES AND CHARGES
FOR THE SEWER WORKS UTILITY

WHEREAS, the City of Rockport, Indiana ("City") operates a sewer works utility for the benefit of the citizens and the surrounding area;

WHEREAS, various ordinances have been adopted from time to time regarding policies and procedures for the sewer works and the establishment of sewer rates, fees and charges;

WHEREAS, the existing rates, fees and charges are set forth in the earlier Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2001-6;

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Common Council, based on a sewer rate study prepared for the City, that the existing rates are inadequate to fund the sewer works utility, and therefore should be amended and modified as provided for in this ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKPORT, INDIANA as follows:

Section 1. of Ordinance 2001-6 is hereby amended and restated to add the following rate:

D. WHOLESALE FLOW CHARGE – for use of and service rendered by the sewer works, each user who meets the City's definition of a wholesale user and has previously paid a capacity charge in an amount agreed to by the City shall be charged in an amount based upon metered sewage flow, determined by the rate and charge shown as follows.

<u>Metered Consumption</u>	<u>Monthly Rate Per 1,000 Gallons</u>
Wholesale Flow Charge – All Gallonage	\$ 2.00

All other provisions of Ordinance No. 2001-6 not amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

The provisions herein, when approved and adopted, shall be effective upon passage.
