**RESOLUTION 2022- 7**

**PLAN FOR PARTIAL EXPENDURE OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN FUNDS**

WHEREAS, ON March 11, 2021, the United States Congress passed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA), which provides fiscal relief funds to State and Local Governments, and other program areas aimed at mitigating the continuing effects of the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, ARPA is intended to provide support to local governments in responding to the impact of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain COVID-19 in their communities, residents, and businesses; and


WHEREAS, ARPA includes State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds to support urgent COVID response efforts to decrease the spread of the virus, to replace lost public sector revenue, to strengthen support for vital public services, to support immediate economic stabilization for households and businesses, and to address systemic public health and economic challenges that have contributed to unequal impacts of the pandemic on certain populations; and


WHEREAS, the United States Department of Treasury has adopted the final rule as guidance regarding the use of ARPA funds; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2021 the State of Indiana Treasury deposited the City of Rockport's first tranche of funds in the amount of \$242,028.16, and on August 17, 2022 the State of Indiana Treasury deposited the City of rockport's second tranche of funds in the amount of \$242,944.27.

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2021 the City of Rockport Common Counsel established the ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund No. 176 through passage of Ordinance 2021-9, which identified the following use of funds:

- a. To respond to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or aid to impacted industries such as tourism, travel, and hospitality;
- b. To respond to workers performing essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency by providing premium pay to eligible workers of Rockport, Indiana that are performing such essential work, or by providing grants to eligible employers that have eligible workers who perform essential work;
- c. For the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue of the City Of Rockport, Indiana due to the COVID-19 public health

emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year of the City Of Rockport, Indiana prior to the public health emergency;

d. To make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure; and/or

e. Funds must be appropriated, disbursed pursuant to the Plan outlined herein, and disbursed pursuant to the normal claims process in I.C. 5-11-10-1.6.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Rockport to approve and adopt the following local plan as it pertains to the expenditure of said a portion of the funds received in the amount of \$400,000.00:

Housing Development - \$400,000.00

WHEREAS, the City of Rockport Common Council understands that this will be a distribution of a portion of the funds distributed pursuant to the American Rescue Plan and expects that in the future the City of Rockport will have an amended local plan for the distribution of additional portions of the funds.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Rockport, as follows:


1. The Common Council hereby adopts the local plan and approves the distribution of the funds pursuant to the above.
2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor as required by law.



Be it ordained/resolved by the **City of Rockport** that for the expenses of **ROCKPORT CIVIL CITY** for the year ending December 31, **2023** the sums herein specified are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the several funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same. Such sums herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided for by law. In addition, for the purposes of raising revenue to meet the necessary expenses of **ROCKPORT CIVIL CITY**, the property tax levies and property tax rates as herein specified are included herein. Budget Form 4-B for all funds must be completed and submitted in the manner prescribed by the Department of Local Government Finance.
